Class I to VIII - Periodic Tests are conducted as per the Examination Schedule given in the year book and a Mid-Term examination in September / October, based on the course covered. Final examinations are held in February / March. Regularity in attendance during all tests is imperative. There is no provision of a retest.

## SCHEME OF EXAMINATIONS AND ASSESSMENTS

1. The academic year is divided into two terms and examinations are held at the end of each term.
2. Evaluation of the Scholastic Aspect will be conducted according to the C.B.S.E guidelines which are tabulated.
3. Attendance for tests for all classes is compulsory.
4. Students found using unfair means during any Periodic Test or Term Examination will be marked zero in that subject. These students will not be eligible for any academic award.
5. Promotion to the higher class will be based on Annual Exam. However, Term I results will be reflected in the report card.
