ANTI-BULLYING POLICY

Bullying is unwanted, aggressive behavior among school aged children, which involves a real or perceived power imbalance. The behavior is repeated, or has the potential to be repeated, over time. Bullying includes actions such as making threats, spreading rumors, attacking someone physically or verbally, and excluding someone from a group on purpose. The same acts committed through any electronic media also falls under the same category.

- ➤ Teachers take all forms of bullying seriously and prevent incidents from taking place. They keep their own records of all the incidents that happen in their class and in the school premises.
- School leaders (student council members) are appointed as Anti bullying squad to monitor the students inside the school campus.
- ➤ If teachers witness an act of bullying, they are instructed to support the child who is being bullied.
- > They also refer the case to the school counsellor.
- ➤ We use render needed counselling to the accused child so that his/her behavior can be changed. If a child is repeatedly involved in bullying other children, it will inform the Principal and the counsellor. If needed the child's parents will be called to the school for a discussion.
- Teachers attempt to support all children in their class and to establish a climate of trust and respect for all. By praising, rewarding and celebrating the success of all children, we aim to prevent incidents of bullying.
